## New PDF statement import straight into Xero

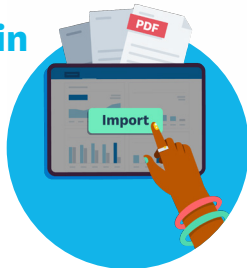

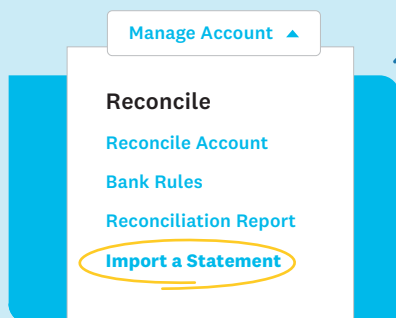

## How it works

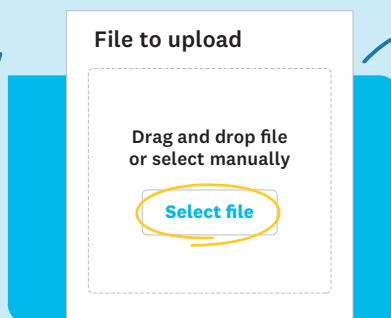
### 1 Select Import a Statement

Choose your bank account, click **Manage Account**, then select **Import a Statement**. It's recommended that you import a PDF statement from a [supported bank](#).



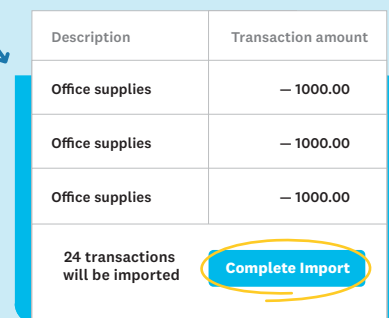
### 2 Select and upload your PDF

Click **Select file** or **Drag and drop** a file to choose a PDF file from your computer.



### 3 Review transactions and complete import

Review the imported transactions for accuracy. Then click **Complete Import**. You're now ready to reconcile your transactions.
