Terms and Conditions

1. These terms will apply to all delegate registrations for the 2026 Xero Asia Roadshow to be held in person at the location and on the date specified in your registration confirmation ("**Event**"). When you register you acknowledge and accept these terms in full. Please note you cannot register on behalf of any other person and each individual must complete a separate booking and obtain the relevant booking confirmation for entry into the Event. Xero reserves the right to alter these terms at any time. Xero will notify you in the event of an amendment to these terms.
2. Xero reserves the right to reject or accept your registration at any time in its absolute discretion. Acceptance of your registration is confirmed by Xero only when the acceptance is communicated to you by email.
3. You agree to comply with all applicable laws and any reasonable instructions issued by Xero or venue management in relation to the Event.
4. You acknowledge that the material presented at and in relation to the Event is subject to intellectual property rights, including (but not limited to) copyright, and cannot be re-used without the written express permission of Xero.
